Ms. Santoshi Rajan has joined as an IBDP – Biology & ESS Facilitator

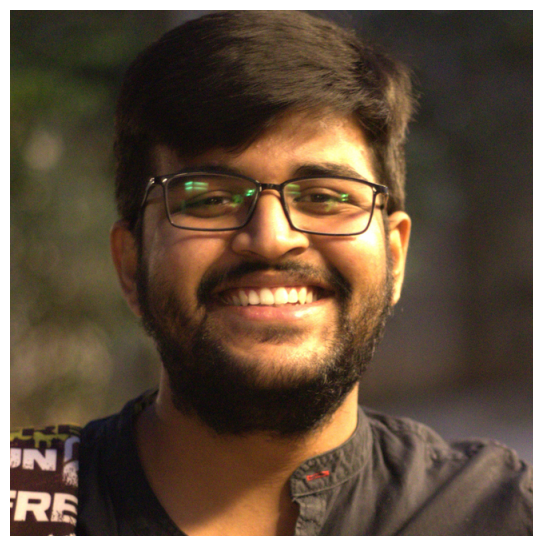
